



charitable HEART

On Sunday, Phil will start a new series called Charitable Heart, a short series focused on the discipline of giving. In this first sermon, Phil will look at the conversation between John the Baptist and the crowds of people coming out to be baptized in the gospel of Luke. There is important teaching in this passage about the responsibility of believers to steward their resources for the Lord.


