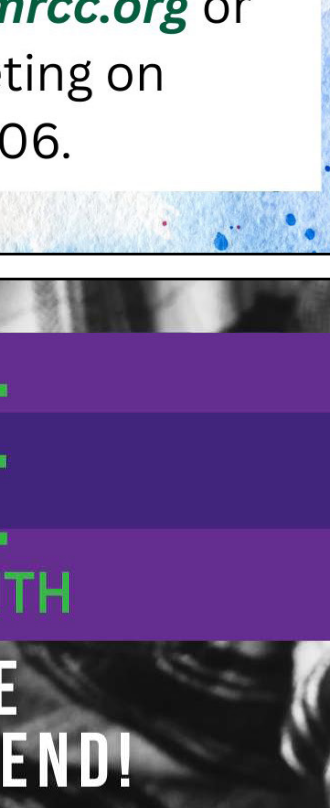

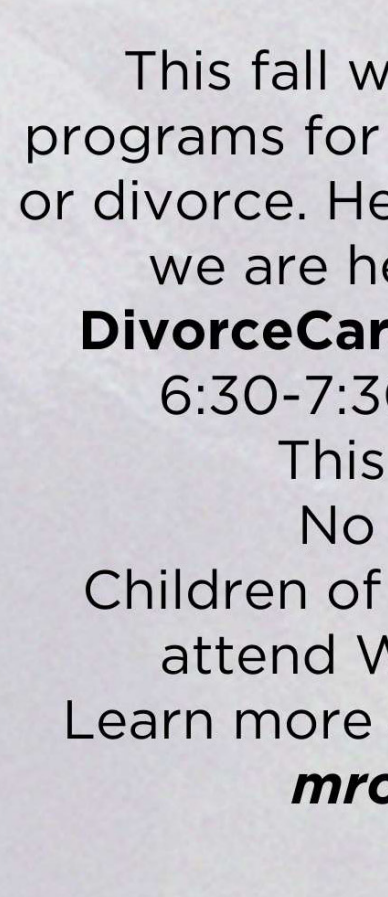
MINISTRY UPDATES

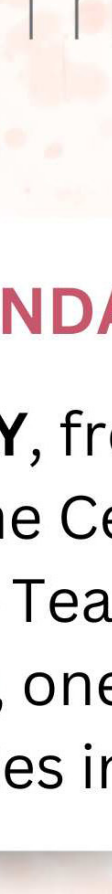

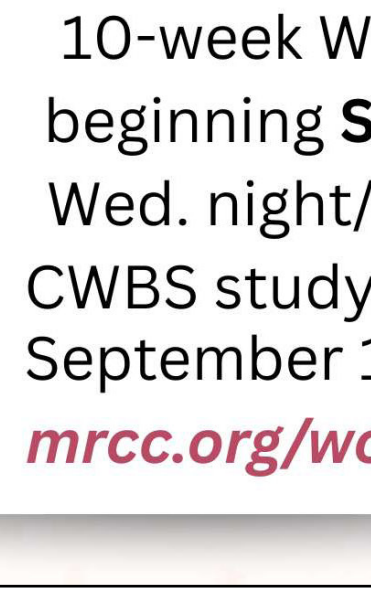

This fall we are offering two support programs for families navigating separation or divorce. Healing from divorce is not easy; we are here to help in this journey.

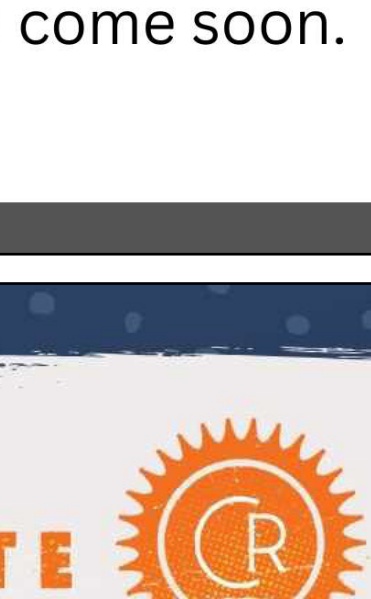
DivorceCare for Adults will meet Wed. 6:30-7:30 pm beginning Sept. 10.
