We removed multiple layers of carpet and pad to put down new tile in one of the cottages. We also traced circuits in electrical panels and labeled outlets and switches in multiple buildings. We set two new basketball goals for the children to use. We built a carport off the shop so that fleet maintenance could be performed while protected from the sun and rain. Lastly, we helped to clean out and organize the shop, a job decades in the making. We are told that most of the jobs we do there just aren't possible to achieve with one person and are too expensive for them to hire out. Many of the larger jobs are held for our group to arrive, and this trip was no exception. There was excellent food, great fellowship, and plenty to do. Our group worked hard and returned home on Friday with sore muscles and new memories.


BELIEVE IN ME


