When we do little things wholeheartedly, God will take care of the rest.

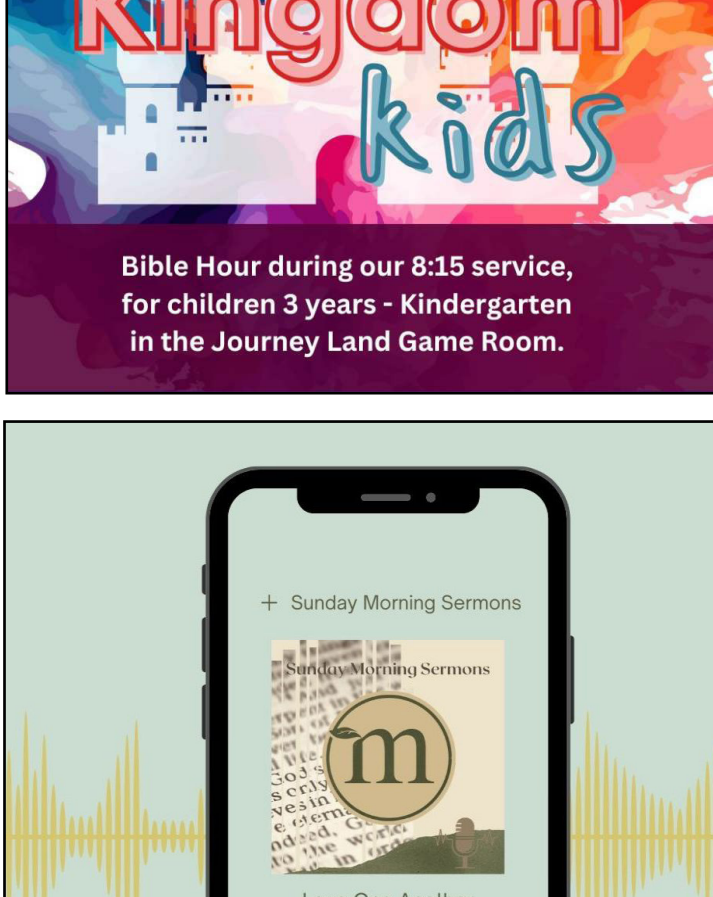


## The One Who Saves
