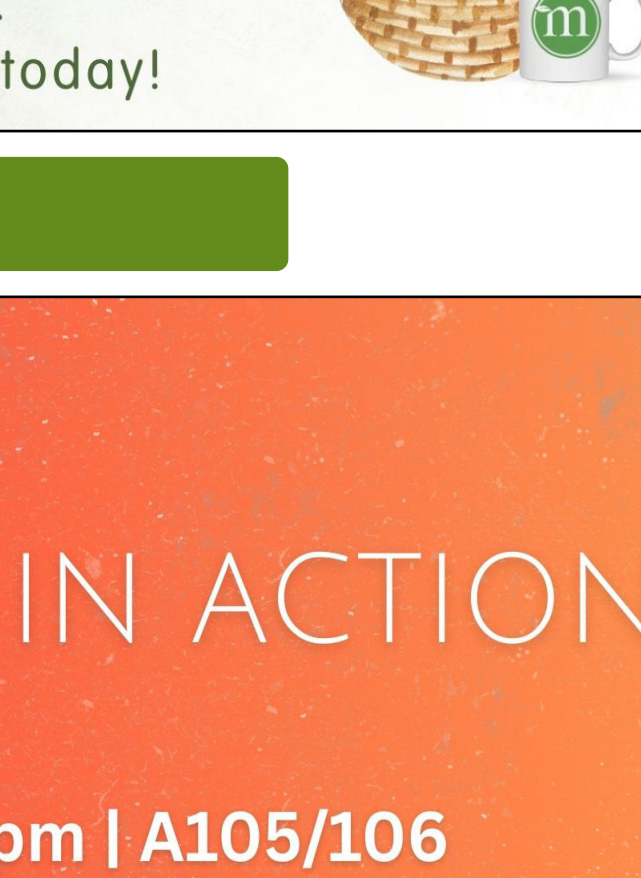



Sunday Morning


